

Saint Jo Riding Club

Arena Use Policy

Active Members of the Saint Jo Riding Club are granted the opportunity to use the Riding Club arena freely with some exceptions. The Rodeo Committee in office shall maintain all rights as to use of arena and property covered by Montague County deed filed 03/10/2008, B-432 P-135.

- Arena can not be used for personal gain. Use of the grounds for free grazing is prohibited.
- Members must notify the current Rodeo Committee Chairman via text, email or phone of intent to use, when and purpose.
- No one will be allowed to leave animals or equipment on grounds for a period of more than 48 hours from initial use date. Exceptions may be made by the Rodeo Committee. Requests for special permissions and use agreements must be made in writing. The written agreement will specify pen assignments.
- Arena grounds may not be used for hunting.
- Must clean up after use.
- Must turn off any and all water and electric when leaving.
- Secure and lock gate upon exiting.
